**Personal Supplies:** Please label these items with your child's name

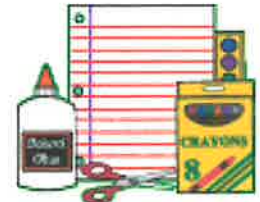

## Class Supplies
