- 3. **Visitors -** All visitors must check in at the front office before entering the building. There is a doorbell to be buzzed in next to the doors on the right side. This is for the safety of our staff and students. The middle school doors will be locked during school hours.

- 4. **Middle School Counselor** Our amazing counselor, Anne Zimmerman is returning this year as our middle school counselor. She will be available Tues-Friday and her office is now located in the middle schoo in Room 414. You can reach her att: azimmerman@griffinschool.us
- 5. **Schedules** Are available on Skyward, and will also be available to pick up at our Open House on 9/5 from 4-6pm.
- 6. **Weekly Bulletin** A Middle school weekly bulletin will be sent out to provide information weekly for families, Each teacher/grade level team will have a space to list assignments, instruction topics, and general activities/events going on in the middle school.
- 7. **Drop Off and Pick Up** Parents can drop off students beginning at 8:35. Please use the drop-off lane. You are welcome to walk your student(s) to the front door as we are continuing to limit the number of parents inside the building. If students arrive before the 8:40 bell, they will need to wait outside until the bell rings. If you need to meet with a staff member, please reach out to schedule a time to meet.
- 8. **Breakfast/Lunch** Breakfast is \$2.00 & Lunch is \$3.40. If you need meal assistance, please fill out the following <u>Free & Reduced Lunch Application</u>.
- 9. **Volunteers in the Building-** We will continue to welcome pre-arranged volunteers into the building. Interested volunteers will need to complete a background check. Background check forms are available in the front office.
- 10. Lockers Middle Schoolers will get lockers assigned in their Flex class over the first/second week of school.
- **11. Cell Phone Policy -** Cell phones must remain in lockers or backpacks during class time, they are not permitted to be out during class. Students can check their devices during passing time and lunch.
