- The Kinship Navigator serves all Kinship Families that reside in Lewis, Mason, and Thurston Counties.
- The Navigator assists Kinship Families in locating resources and services that will assist them as they raise kinship children.
- The Navigator can accompany you to CPS Meetings, Family Court Hearings, and school IEP Meetings to provide support and encouragement.
- The Navigator administers the KCSP, which provides one time financial grants to low-income Kinship Families.
- The Navigator is not a lawyer, and is unable to provide legal advice or assist you in completing any legal paperwork.


